Multiple myeloma is the **second** most common hematologic malignancy in the world¹



Men are 1.5x more likely to develop multiple myeloma than women¹



Each year there are more than **130,000** new diagnoses of multiple myeloma worldwide²



This disease is most frequently diagnosed in people between 65—74 years old²

SIGNS and SYMPTOMS³



Shortness of breath or evidence of heart or kidney failure



Nervous system disorders



Persistent tiredness due to anemia or kidney failure



Recurrent unexplained infections, such as pneumonia (lungs)



Bone pain that is persistent or recurrent, and fractures
